On May 16, 2015 Bobby Lajeunesse of St. Vincent, formerly of Calgary & Sault Ste. Marie, ON., was in a tragic accident and passed away suddenly at the age of 38 years. Bobby enjoyed farming with his in-laws, Richard and Lois, and looked forward to Christine's home cooked meals that reminded him of his mother, Nicole's cooking. Bobby passed on his passion for sports to his sons & young Jack has become quite a hockey player.
